Other information :

Addie was built in 1915 by Isaac Abdulla and Mitchel in Brimscombe, Port Stroud. She started life as a working tug boat in the Severn Estuary and Bristol Channel. In 1940 British Waterways purchased the boat and continued to operate in the Bristol Channel for a further 20 years, until 1960 when Addie was sold to a private owner and converted to a gentlemen's motor launch.

In the late eighties - early nineties, Addie underwent a major restoration project. The hull and topsides were replaced. She was converted from single screw to a twin screw and new engines fitted. A complete internal refit took place. All of which was overseen by Marine surveyors, documentation and photographic history is available.

This boat has been fitted out to a high standard. There is a large saloon, Galley area with seating, two heads, one with wash basin and the other with shower and bath. Accommodation for 5 adults in 3 cabins. An ideal live aboard or long distance cruiser.

Addie is a sea worthy vessel and has cruised to Menorca in 1999, travelled around the Balearic islands and back to the UK in 2005.
